

ART/E/FACT - Publications and Exhibitions of Art and Anthropology Call For Submissions

An academic resource and an online exhibition, ART/E/FACT is designed to be a forum for artists and anthropologists to use their own mediums to approach the space where the anthropology and the arts intersect; the first of its kind.

This interdisciplinary multimedia publication will be published biannually as an open access volume of essays, artworks and media productions. Additionally, the publication aims to present media submissions via exhibitions worldwide.

The first volume of ART/E/FACT, On Dialogue, encourages artists and anthropologists to submit essays and media submissions from previous or current work, or to identify connections between the social sciences and art. For a productive dialogue, the submissions should focus on the similarities or differences of the two disciplines, examining the experience of interdisciplinary inquiry while retaining their integrity as unique practices. Evidence of these similarities should be accounts of experiences: examples of similarities could be where artists have used anthropology in the shaping of an art-piece or anthropologists have used the visual, aural and audiovisual mediums within their respective disciplines. Other approaches and contributions to the dialogue are welcome.
